Corydalis – The premier Chinese herb for pain and insomnia

Amla- -vision, world's highest vitamin C content and antioxidant

Zizyphus- used with methylxanthines (such as green tea) to tonify and promote stamina

Arjuna – The premier heart remedy of Ayurveda

Notopterygii – A lesser-known Chinese herb for joints

Clove – An outstanding herb for neuromuscular conditions

Cinnamon – This simple herb is one of the best therapies for menstrual cramps

Nutmeg – A powerful relaxant for stress, anxiety, insomnia

Chiles – Extremely effective for depression when used properly

Gotu Kola - scars, connective tissue, MS
